MASON PHELPS ENDOWMENT



In honor of Mason Phelps, the former President and Chairman of the Board of Directors of the National Horse Show, the events Executive

Committee has decided to establish a fund in his honor. Mason was a tireless advocate for the National Horse Show's success and longevity. He worked to preserve the history of the event and make sure that it stayed on the cutting edge of equestrian sport in the United States. LEO CONROY EQUITATION GRANT

Leo Conroy, co-manager of the National Horse Show and Chairman of the ASPCA Maclay Finals, passed away early in January, 2015. Leo was



a valuable asset to the NHS and a devoted supporter. To commemorate his loyalty and dedication, the National Horse Show has established a grant fund in his name: The Leo Conroy Equitation Grant. This grant will be awarded to up to five (5) riders from each of the three Equitation Championships at the National Horse Show: The ASPCA Maclay Finals, the Hamel Foundation NHS 3'3" Equitation Championship, and the Taylor Harris Insurance Services NHS Adult Equitation Championship. The grant will be awarded to riders who demonstrate a financial need in order to participate in their divisions at the National Horse Show.

THE NATIONAL HORSE SHOW INTRODUCES the creation of the Hamel Foundation NHS 3'3" and THIS Adult Equitation Area Championship classes



These Area Championship classes will be run using the same format as our own Maclay Regional Finals. Open to any riders that have earned points in these classes during the current competition year, these classes are designed to give our members an opportunity to gain experience and to compete on a larger scale against other riders from their same geographical area. The Champion, Reserve Champion and Thirdplace finisher from each Area Championship, if not otherwise qualified, will receive invitations to compete in the Hamel Foundation NHS 3'3" Equitation Finals or the THIS Adult Equitation Finals. Riders that are qualified for both the Hamel Foundation National Horse Show 3'3" Equitation Championship and the Maclay Regionals (and/or the Maclay Finals) may enter and compete in both the Hamel Foundation NHS 3'3" Area Championship and the ASPCA Maclay Regionals.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

This show is a regular member of the United States Equestrian Federation. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

ENTRY CLOSING DATE: Entries are due by **September 6, 2023.**

ENTRIES:

ONLY ONLINE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED (Horseshowonline.com). New entries (new or different horses) made after these dates will incur a one time late fee of \$75.00. **Every Entry Blank must have the signature of the owner/authorized agent, trainer & be accompanied by a stall check, open check or valid credit card information.** It is the responsibility of the person making the entry to execute properly and complete all necessary information pertaining to each entry made in accordance with USEF rules. **NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT AN OPEN CHECK OR VALID CREDIT CARD INFORMATION.** There will be a \$75.00 office/services fee for every horse on the show grounds. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason. **Horses, on the grounds, not entered in any classes, must have a completed entry blank on file in the office and will be charged a \$100 non-showing fee per week. Horses not accruing a minimum of \$100 in entry fees may be charged the non-showing fee in lieu of entry fees.**

***Warning: Horses that compete in a class in which they are not properly entered will be charged a double entry fee. *Attention foreign exhibitors: All fees MUST be paid in "US Funds".**

COMPETITION NUMBERS: OFFICE ISSUED NUMBERS must be worn in the competition rings.

SAFE SPORT: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement, to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

ADDS/SCRATCHES: Adds and scratches must be done through horseshowonline.com the day before showing. **ALL ADDS MUST BE COMPLETED IN THE SHOW OFFICE NO LATER THAN 4:00pm THE DAY PRIOR TO THE CLASS.** Time permitting, same Day Adds may be accepted in the show office. Scratches will be accepted at any time prior to the start of the class – Scratch Fee may apply. Any scratches in the Derby after 4:00pm the night prior to the Class will incur a \$35 Scratch Fee.

SETTLEMENT OF ACCOUNTS: All show accounts must be closed out at the end of each week. Any open entry accounts will be closed by management and a \$60 processing fee will be added per entry. All questions about show accounts must be addressed within 48 hours of the conclusion of the show. Any mistakes or questions regarding your horse show account and/or prize money must be resolved within 48 hours by contacting the Horse Show Office. **FOR CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS PLEASE NOTE: You MUST have your credit card present at check out.**

NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS: A \$50.00 SERVICE FEE OR 10% OF THE CHECK AMOUNT/CREDIT CARD CHARGE, WHICHEVER IS GREATER, WILL BE CHARGED FOR ALL RETURNED CHECKS AND/OR DECLINED CREDIT CARDS.

REFUNDS: STALL FEES CANNOT BE REFUNDED AFTER SEPTEMBER 6. Entry fees will not be refunded after September 6 unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian, or a doctor's note regarding rider illness/injury, is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the office **BEFORE** the start of the classes being scratched. In either case the entry fees will be refunded less any nominating fees, stall fee, and an office processing charge of \$75.00.

CREDIT CARD FEE: A convenience fee of three percent of the total invoice will be added to all invoices being paid with a credit card.

CAMPERS: Camper spaces are available for \$300 per week in spaces 34-96. The Premier camper spaces are available for \$350 per week in spaces 1-30. One Pump-out is included in the weekly fee. Anyone needing additional pump-outs will incur an additional charge.

STALLS: Permanent and temporary stabling will be available at a cost of \$325 for the week. Ship-ins will be charged a \$55 ground/clean up fee per horse per day. Stalls will be available for move-in on Monday, September 18, 2023. 12x12 and 10 X 10 permanent stalls, with doors and mats are available. Stalls must be returned to GSEC in the same condition upon move-in. All nails, hooks, etc. must be removed from stalls upon move-out. No sharing of stalls allowed. Each horse will be charged either a stall fee or a grounds fee. Shavings and feed are available for purchase on show grounds between 7am -5pm. No outside Shavings Permitted. Violators will be charged \$100 per stall.

SHARPS DISPOSAL: Sharps containers will be provided in all barns for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. **ALL** items of this nature **MUST** be disposed of in the provided containers. **NO SHARPS** are to be disposed of in any receptacle other than the provided sharps container. **Any individual or entity not in compliance will be subject to a \$100 fine per USEF 1210.4.**

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

USEF/USHJA FEES: Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Each horse entered must pay the \$15.00 USEF Drug/Medication Fee plus an \$8.00 USEF fee. Each horse entered will also be required to pay the USHJA Fee of \$7.00. (Total USEF/USHJA Fees \$30.00).

NOMINATING FEE: Horses competing in all 1.20 Meter classes, and above, must pay a nominating fee of \$150 unless otherwise noted.

RINGSIDE AMENITIES FEE: This \$50 fee includes the cost of show ring scoreboards & scoreboard operators, horse show app lease & daily uploads, live streaming & display monitors for ringside instant replay. Main rings are equipped with scoreboards. The show app allows you to have all the updated information for the week at your fingertips. Grand Prix and International Derbys will be live streamed @ www.JK-videography.com. All rings are equipped with an outdoor monitor to view an instant replay of your completed round. The \$50 fee includes online viewing of the entire show including your rounds for the duration of the horse show. Video downloads are subjected to additional fees. The \$50 fee is limited to two charges per owner/leasee per show.

NIGHT WATCH FEE: All horses occupying a stall, showing and non showing, will be required to pay a show night watch fee of \$25 per show. Horses will be checked each night of the show week every 2 hours. This service is NOT optional. HJ107i. Night Watch: Security and monitoring service offered to exhibitors, which must be available to contract at an addition cost, for horses stabled on the grounds.

HORSE REGISTRATIONS: All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Proof of registration must be presented to the Show Secretary before numbers can be released. To be eligible for National, Regional or Zone Horse of the Year Awards, and to enter a USEF Computer Ranking List Class horses must also be registered with the USEF. Exception for USEF Computer Ranking List: Citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation need not have USEF Registration.

CREDENTIALS: ALL EXHIBITORS IN ANY PONY, PONY EQUITATION, JUNIOR HUNTER OR AMATEUR SECTION MUST PRESENT THEIR CREDENTIALS (MEASUREMENT CARD OR AMATEUR CERTIFICATION) TO THE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE THEIR NUMBERS CAN BE RELEASED. Please submit a photo copy of credentials with entry to facilitate processing. All horses or ponies without a valid measurement card will be measured at a designated time and place. Anyone not presenting valid membership credentials (USEF/USHJA) will be charged a \$30.00 non-refundable show pass fee for USHJA and \$45.00 non-refundable show pass fee for USEF. Amateur exhibitors must present valid Amateur Credentials. **Only a parent will be exempt from the Federation non-member fee if signing as coach for his/her minor child.**

ANIMAL WELFARE: We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion and should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times, while the horse is on the show grounds, we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse. Abuse and use of whips will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of bamboo off-set or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. The well being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators may be subject to penalties pursuant to USEF rules. **In the event of an acute and serious injury to or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse or agent of the owner is not present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, competition management, in consultation with a licensed equine veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.**

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: GR845 EQUINE VACCINATION RULE: Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the show grounds. Horses without proper proof of vaccines will not be permitted to enter the show grounds.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES / COGGINS TEST: A Health certificate dated within 21 days of arrival to be presented when entering the show grounds. CVI must state the horse(s) has not been treated for an elevated temperature or anything related to herd health in the last 30 days. Horses without a Health certificate will not be permitted to enter the show grounds. Texas law requires that each horse be accompanied by a negative EIA certificate dated within one year. Horses without a negative EIA certificate will not be permitted to enter the show grounds.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

HEALTH CERTIFICATES / COGGINS TEST: A Health certificate dated within 21 days of arrival to be presented when entering the show grounds. CVI must state the horse(s) has not been treated for an elevated temperature or anything related to herd health in the last 30 days. Horses without a Health certificate will not be permitted to enter the show grounds. Texas law requires that each horse be accompanied by a negative EIA certificate dated within one year. Horses without a negative EIA certificate will not be permitted to enter the show grounds.

RINGS/FOOTING: Outside ESI Ring is approximately 140' x 275' with ESI Footing. Mega Ring is approximately 145' x 265' with All Weather footing. ESI Footing. Tellepsen Indoor Arena is approximately 150' x 250' with Sandy Loam Footing. Main Indoor arena is 150' x 300' with ESI Footing. Wheelless Arena (East Indoor) is 125' x 250' with Sandy Loam Footing. Sand Ring is approximately 125' x 250' with All Weather Footing. D-Barn is approximately 90' x 178' with Sandy Loam Footing. Footing is a priority; rings may be closed to schooling during inclement weather and/or for maintenance at any time during the show at the manager's discretion.

WARM UP AND LUNGEING AREAS: Main Jumper Warm Up Ring is 175' x 90' (ESI Footing). West War Up Ring is 120' x 60' (ESI Sport Footing). Wheelless Warm Up Ring is 120' x 150' (Sandy Loam Footing). East Lunging Area is 100' x 150' (All Weather Footing). D Barn Lunging Area is 90' x 178' (Sandy Loam Footing). Tellepsen Lunging Area is 120' x 160' (All Weather Footing). Sand Ring is 125' x 250' (All Weather Footing).

SCHOOLING: Hunter Rings will be open for schooling on the day prior to the show. Time permitting, rings may also be open before and after the show, each day, for hacking, times to be posted or announced. No manual poling; no offsets of any type may be used while schooling. **Jumping will be permitted, in the rings, at scheduled times and only when medical personnel are on the grounds.**

ATTIRE/HEADGEAR: All riders must be properly attired. Protective head gear must be worn **BY ALL RIDERS AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED**, anywhere, anytime on the show grounds. Headgear for **all riders** must meet or exceed ASTM Standards; must carry the SEI tag; and be properly secured by a harness.

JUMP ORDER: Show Management will determine a rotating jump order for all classes over fences. Riders or Trainers with conflicts must see the paddock masters in both rings so that the necessary adjustments can be made. **Starters have the authority to scratch entries that make no attempt to be timely, without going through the Manager.**

COURSES: Courses will be posted a minimum of 30 minutes prior to each class. In Hunter classes, fences will simulate fences found in the hunt field such as; brush, wall, in & out, oxe, post and rails, and gates. At management's discretion, a dotted line may be put into effect to restrict the size of the courtesy circle in hunter classes.

JUMPERS: Ties in jumper classes will jump off for first place only. Ties for all other places will be determined by first round time. Champion and Reserve will be determined using the 10,6,4,2,1,1/2 Bonus Point system. Bonus Points will apply to the class indicated for each section.

CHANGES: Management reserves the right to change, cancel, or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

RIBBONS/TROPHIES/CHAMPIONSHIPS: All hunter classes receive a trophy and eight ribbons unless otherwise noted. All equitation classes receive a trophy and six ribbons unless otherwise noted. All jumper classes receive a trophy and six ribbons unless otherwise noted. Each hunter and jumper section will receive a champion & reserve award based on points unless otherwise noted. Full Championship points will be given in all classes in each hunter section **except** Green Conformation Hunter Model which will count as half points. In all hunter sections, Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded to two of the top four horses acquiring the most points over fences. These four horses will also receive full points for one under saddle class. All ribbons and prizes can be picked up at the designated Ribbon and Prize room located in the offices next to the Main Arena.

PRIZE MONEY: Prize money is indicated for each class. Prize money won can be paid by check or deducted from each horses account. An IRS W-9 form must be completed in full before any prize money can be paid. Prize money will be withheld if the recipients Social Security number or EIN number is not on file. Prize money will be payable to the owner unless written authorization, and **complete** alternate payee information, is on file with the show secretary. All prize money will be paid within 30 days of the shows' conclusion.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO: From time to time, events at this facility are taped or produced for live and/or delayed broadcast on National Television. The copyrights of any video production at the Great Southwest Equestrian Center remain the property of the Great Southwest Equestrian Center. No portion of any event may be copied, sold or rebroadcast (except non-economic use by the event participants) without the express written consent of the Great Southwest Equestrian Center - Katy, TX. All copyrights are reserved under the Federal Copyright Laws of The United States.

PHOTO RELEASE: By signing the entry form, I agree to waive the right to the use of my photos/videos at the competition and grant Southbound Show Management, Great Southwest Equestrian Center and its agent's full use of any and all competition photos and video.

DOGS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. **Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors.** Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to a \$100 fine. In addition, pursuant to facility regulations. Loose dogs will be removed by animal control, from the show grounds, at the owner's expense.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

OPERATION OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

TICKETED SCHOOLING: Information regarding ticketed schooling will be posted in the show office.

HUNTER PRIZE MONEY:

The total amount of hunter prize money being offered is \$44,600 with a minimum payout of \$12,000.

In 2022: The total amount of hunter prize money offered was \$68,800 and \$73,750 was paid out.

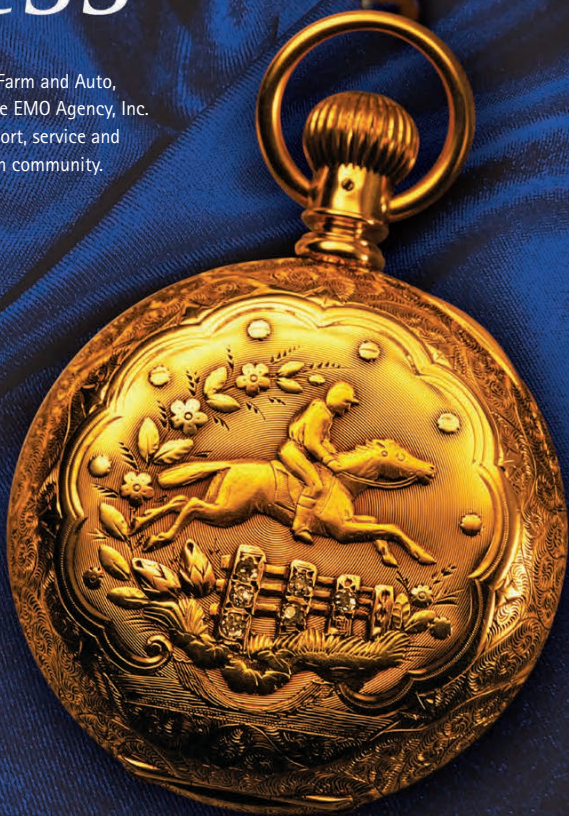

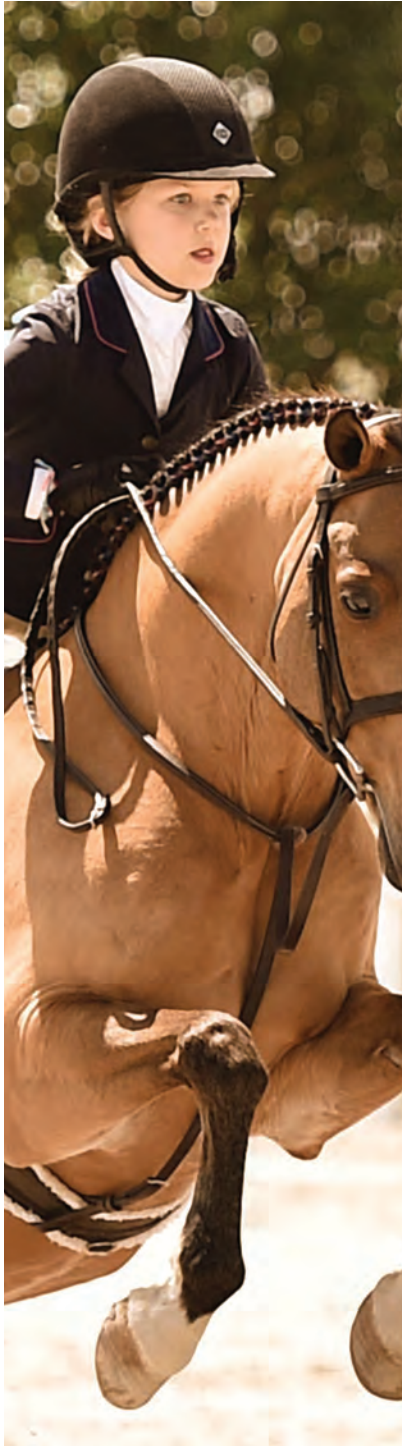

Management may elect to hold the Jumper Phase as a Table II, 1.2c (Power & Speed) competition, in which case the Time Allowed will apply only in the "speed" phase and must be computed at 382 yards per minute. Further testing will be optional; USEF tests 1-19.

Combining/Dividing Sections: The Children's Hunter Pony and the Children's Hunter Horse sections may, but are not required to be combined if there are fewer than four (4) entries in the Children's Hunter Pony and fewer than six (6) in the Children's Hunter Horse section. Children's Hunter Pony may not be combined with Adult Amateur Hunter. Awards: Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: Children's Hunter Pony- Small/Medium, Children's Hunter Pony- Large. Required Distances for the Children's Hunter Pony Sections: If the distance between related fences is fewer than 100' (including in and outs), the distance must be adjusted for small, medium and large ponies. Small Children's Pony – 9'9", Medium Children's Pony – 10'3", Large Children's Pony – 11'.

CHILDREN'S JUMPER: Classes to be scored under Table I; Table II, Section 1, Sections 2(a), 2(b), 2(c), or 3; or Table IV (Optimum Time). Sections offered and Requirements: Low Children's Jumper, High Children's Jumper. Cross Entry: Competition Management may restrict cross entries between High and Low sections at the same competition if stated in the prize list. Rider: n/a. Horse/Pony: n/a. Horse and Rider Combination: Cross entry into any class at 1.20m and above is not permitted for the same horse/rider combination at the same competition. Low Children's Jumper horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the High Children's Jumpers at the same competition. High Children's Jumper horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the Low Children's Jumpers at the same competition. Horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered. Fence Height: Low Children's Jumper 1.00m to 1.05m, High Children's Jumper 1.10m to 1.15m. Combining/Dividing Sections: A combined Adult Amateur/Children's Jumper section may be offered, and if entries warrant, may thereafter be split into separate sections. If only one section of the Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper is offered or if the Low and High section are combined, the classes will be conducted at the height appropriate for each section (1.00m- 1.05m for Low and 1.10m- 1.15m for High). Awards: Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section: Low Children's Jumper section, High Children's Jumper section.

AGE GROUP EQUITATION: CHILDREN'S/JUNIOR SECTION: To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability to count. Sections Offered: Junior Equitation 14 & Under, Junior Equitation 15- 17. Cross Entry: Rider: n/a. Horse: n/a. Horse and Rider Combination: A horse rider combination may not cross enter between height sections. Fence Height: Junior Equitation 14 & Under: 3'0" with spreads not to exceed fence height, Junior Equitation 15- 17: 3'6" with spreads not to exceed fence height. Combinations will be permitted. Combining/Dividing Sections: The Equitation sections may be combined if there are fewer than six (6) entries in a section. Awards: Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: Equitation 14 & Under, Equitation 15- 17.
